

Guatemala, Puerto Quetzal/Antigua

There's really nothing much to see here at the cruise port. The nearest center of interest is the town of Antigua about eighty Km (fifty miles) away. I checked with a couple transport companies and was quoted one hundred fifty dollars round trip. The cruise line offers an "on your own" excursion for a much more economical price - \$59.00 p/p. Basically they provide transportation both ways and a map. This was what we did last time.

I was able to find some information I thought I had lost, and with the help of the internet, I was able to assemble a series of short Walking Tours of Antigua in PDF form together with maps. Each map specifies the time to complete.

If one were to print them out and assemble several together, one could do a fairly organized tour, but on our last visit, we just used them to identify landmarks as we wandered.
